- 1. Athletes will first be evaluated on tumbling skills.
- 2. Step 2 we will separate by the USASF age divisions
- 3. Step 3 we will create stunt positions.



#### What to expect during the All Star Season 24-25

**Level 1** - This is the beginning level of All Star cheer. This team will train twice a week, for 1 hour each practice. There will be minimal travel for this team. They will perform/compete at 5 to 6 competitions plus the end of season showcase. All the competitions will be held in Oklahoma.

**Level 2** - Back-handspring and round off back handspring are performed at this level. This team will train twice a week for 1.5 hours each practice. They will perform/compete at 5 to 6 competitions plus the end of season showcase. Most of the competitions will be held in Oklahoma plus one or two travel competitions in Texas or Kansas.

**Level 3** - Series of back-handsprings round off back-tuck are performed at this level. This team will train twice a week with 1 hour and 45 minutes per practice. They will perform/compete at 5 to 6 competitions plus the end of season showcase. Most of the competitions will be held in Oklahoma with a few travel competitions in Texas and/or Kansas.

**Level 4** - Standing back-tuck and round off back-handspring lay-out are performed at this level. This team will train twice a week with occasional extra practices during the season. They will compete in 5 to 6 competitions (NCA as one of the competitions) plus the end of season showcase and will consider an end of season bid event.

**Level 5-** Toe touch - back-tuck and back-handspring layout and round-off backhandspring full twist are performed at this level. This team is a highly competitive team competing at two-day events throughout the season. (NCA and Summit) They will compete in Oklahoma, Texas and Kansas plus the end of season showcase and the Summit held in Orlando, Florida.

**Level 6-** Standing back-handspring full twisting skills and running full twisting skills with double fulls are performed at this level. This team is Highly competitive and requires travel to World bid qualifying events throughout the United States. The World Championship will be held in Orlando, Florida at the end of April.
